- Apply the ABCDE approach of Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) to the initial assessment and management of patients with suspected head injury.
- Perform a focused history and neurological physical examination for neuro-trauma patients in both prehospital and emergency department settings.
- Identify and initiate key resuscitative measures and emergency interventions for patients presenting with neuro-trauma in the emergency department.
- Recognize common neuro-trauma pathologies on imaging and describe appropriate initial management strategies for each.
